Acer palmatum 'JWW7' PP#30,091

Spice up the landscape with the graceful, fast-growing, own-root Japanese maple! Already a hit in Europe, the ever-changing color of its foliage sets it apart: leaves emerge bright red in spring, which darkens to a chocolate-red before turning green. All season, new growth continues to emerge red, before the whole tree blazes brilliant scarlet in autumn.


▼ UNCOMMON THREAD™

Acer palmatum 'SMNAPK' PPAF; CBRAF

This attractive, upright Japanese maple combines their classic appeal with own-root vigor and a faster than average growth rate. The deeply cut, fresh green leaves show a hint of orange in the spring and hues of red in autumn. Graceful habit and a versatile medium size will make it a popular choice at retail.

SPRING GLORY®

Amelanchier canadensis 'Sprizam'

SPRING GLORY *Amelanchier* combines everything that's so beloved about this native tree: profuse spring bloom, sweet fruit, glorious fall color, and adds in a dwarf, compact habit that greatly expands the ways in which it can be used in the landscape or garden. Its short stature makes it perfectly suited for planting around utility lines and buildings.

AVALANCHE™

Betula × 'Avalzam'

AVALANCHE birch combines exceptional smooth white bark with a ruggedness and durability that withstands challenging conditions and resists bronze birch borer. Bark starts out tan, takes on pink tones and then turns that bright, stunning white. Neat emerald green leaves develop golden fall color.

Cercis canadensis 'Luclavzam'

LUSCIOUS LAVENDER redbud has the brightest, richest flower color of any redbud. Blooms appear before the neat heart-shaped leaves emerge. Few seeds form, so nothing distracts from the beauty of this small tree.

GOLDEN SHADOWS®

Cornus alternifolia 'Wstackman' PP#11,287

Pagoda dogwood is noted for its strongly horizontal branching. GOLDEN SHADOWS dogwood makes that habit even more dramatic with yellow and green variegated foliage. It often emerges with shades of red and orange, accompanied in spring by lacy white flowers. At its best when planted in light, filtered shade.

Cornus florida 'PGCFPP' PPAF; CBRAF

A charming dogwood with flowers that emerge peachy-pink, and then transition to white with a pink blush before showing pure white. Selected by Powell Gardens in Kingsville, Missouri, for its unique flower color, hardiness, and clean, healthy foliage.

CRUSADER®

Crataegus crus-galli var. *inermis* 'Cruzam'

In addition to its abundant white floral display in late spring, attractive silver bark, colorful fall foliage, and showy fruit, this thornless native hawthorn tolerates just about any challenge you can give it. It shrugs off wet and dry soils, is not fussy about pH levels, is unbothered by clay or salt, and resists the many diseases that often plague the rose family.

Ginkgo biloba 'Menhir' PP#24,226

Enjoy the magic of this ancient tree anywhere with SKINNY FIT ginkgo! This unusual selection naturally grows as a narrow column. Fabulous fan-shaped leaves turn brilliant gold in autumn for a truly unforgettable display.

TEMPLE OF BLOOM®

Heptacodium miconioides 'SMNHMRF' PP#30,763

TEMPLE OF BLOOM heptacodium improves on the straight species with a more compact habit and an earlier bloom, which means that its cherry-red bracts show up sooner for a memorable fall display. Handsome, high quality foliage and attractive peeling bark make this truly a plant for all seasons.

LOLLIPOP®

Malus 'Lollizam'

True to its name, this useful crabapple is a confection of fragrant white flowers in spring perched on top of a sturdy trunk. Tiny, shiny red fruits in fall attract birds and wildlife. Thanks to its truly dwarf genetics, it perpetually maintains the neat form that will make homeowners everywhere fall in love with it.

SWEET SUGAR TYME®

Malus 'Swesutyzam'

While Sweet SUGAR TYME crabapple produces hundreds of beautiful white blooms in spring and has an appealing, compact, oval habit, what really sets it apart is its fruit. It's abundant, it's vivid red, and most notably, it's incredibly persistent. The fruits stay round, robust, and bright red clear through the following spring for a stunning display.

SHOW TIME™

Malus 'Shotizam'

The large, densely-clustered fuchsia-red flowers turn the branches into columns of lush color. Deep green foliage has red tones of its own, especially as it emerges. In fall, red fruits glisten among the bright orange and red leaves. Recommended as a replacement for 'Prairifire' by Ohio State University.

PERSIAN SPIRE™

Parrotia persica 'JL Columnar' PP#24,951

A remarkably colorful and dynamic columnar ironwood with leaves emerge purple, then transition to green with a purple margin, and then to a dark emerald green in summer. Autumn does not disappoint as you get rich foliar display of yellow, orange, and red and winter brings interesting exfoliating bark in a patchwork of gray, green, white and brown. Plus, you get all of this with an appealing fastigiate, space-saving habit.

^ PINK SNOW SHOWERS™

Prunus × 'Pisnshzam'

Its elegant, arching branches are a flurry of sweet pink flowers in early spring, standing out against the silvery branches. Serrated, dark green foliage has no issue with unsightly shot hole disease, staying clean all season before developing into red and orange tones in fall. This vigorous grower quickly develops into a showpiece.

> WEEPING EXTRAORDINAIRE™

Prunus × 'Extrazam'

A bold display of the double powderpuff blooms emerge deep pink and open to a beautiful light cherry hue. When the blooms fall from the weeping branches, coppery foliage emerges, quickly turning an appealing emerald green before going red and burgundy in autumn.

^ MARLEY'S PINK™

Styrax japonicus 'JLWeeping' PP#23,755

Japanese styrax is widely appreciated as one of the prettiest small trees available, and Marley's Pink styrax gilds the lily with beautiful pink flowers instead of the typical white, and an elegant weeping habit. Glossy green foliage turns bright yellow in fall on this truly sweet and useful tree. Developed by John Lewis of JLPN Nursery in Oregon.

< STARWAY TO HEAVEN™

Styrax japonicus 'RNI-Rixred' PP#35,353

Japanese snowbell deserves to be more popular, and Starway to Heaven reblooming styrax ought to help it on this journey. Its fragrant, five-petaled flowers do indeed resemble a galaxy of stars when it blooms in spring - and then again in fall, when it reblooms. Each flower has a shimmering, almost metallic effect that sparkles in the landscape. Deep green foliage emerges red, and its narrow, space-saving habit beautifies landscapes both large and small.

SWAN SONG™

Styrax japonicus 'ORSTSTYx1' PP#36,388

Bring drama and gravitas to the landscape with this incredible dark leafed Japanese snowbell. Its graceful, narrow weeping habit is bedecked with glossy dark purple foliage, and graced with lightly fragrant, soft pink flowers in late spring.


