

Durable native groundcover shrub

Looking for a replacement for Rhus 'Gro-Low'? Check out this remarkable new dwarf Aronia. White spring flowers are just the start of the show: glossy green foliage turns brilliant red in fall, and black fruit are quite ornamental. Quite possibly the perfect landscape plant, it's adaptable to most soils, doesn't need pruning, and provides multi-season interest in the landscape! One just isn't enough, so use it for mass plantings and edging.
