Grower Tips:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Frequent trimming produces the best looking finished plant. • Blooms on old wood; stop pruning in mid-summer before sale season to allow flower buds to form. • If fruit is desired for presentation, do not prune after blooming. • Low Scape Snowfire is faster to produce than Low Scape Hedger is.
