Grower Tips:

- Do not grow in neutral or alkaline soils.
- Naturally forms a tight, compact mound, so minimal trimming is required to produce an appealing plant.
- Watch for aphids, especially in spring.
- For 3 gallon plants, use a 1 gallon shift rather than potting liners directly to the can. Allow 10-12 weeks in addition to the amount of time required to produce the 1 gallon.
- This dwarf variety finishes in about the same amount of time as other clethra varieties but will be smaller.
