<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bushy broadleaf evergreen brings lush, year-round color to warm climates. - Variegated yellow and green foliage develops orange tones in cool weather. - Naturally grows as a rounded mound, but can be clipped or trained to formal shapes. - Can be used as seasonal color in cold climates; grows well indoors as a houseplant.

Grower Tips:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Year round sales window as this plant is evergreen and has showy foliage. • Prune to shape as desired: it lends itself to topiary and other formal pruning methods. • Tolerates hard pruning into old wood. • Well drained soil is a must. • Potting a 2 ¼" liner directly to a 3 gallon is not recommended.
