| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prune frequently through the growing season to encourage a full, appealing container. Trim out any errant shoots and any reversions that appear. • Will not develop good color under poly or shade – place in sun for a few weeks before sale. • The occasional reversion may appear and should be pruned out. • A good choice for fall-winter color sales for color in containers or holiday décor. • Potting a 2 ¼" liner directly to a 3 gallon is not recommended. |
