Grower Tips:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unforgettable Fire is a superior production plant that produces a fuller container faster than other varieties. • Burning bush are very heavy feeders and will quickly show signs of low nutrition. If leaves are small, chlorotic, or pale green, adjust fertilizer regimen. • A hard dormant prune is essential for producing a full, well-branched plant. Late fall is the best time for this. Prune an addition 2 times after growth begins in spring. • Watch for spider mites, treat as necessary. • For fall color sales, plants must be outdoors in full sunlight for several weeks to attain best color. • Potting a 2 ¼" liner directly to a 3 gallon is not recommended.
