Grower Tips:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blooms on old wood; stop pruning in mid-summer before year of sale to allow flower buds to form. • Southern growers should site plants in part shade. • Very few pests bother fothergilla if all cultural requirements are met. • Excellent fall color can boost fall sales. • Branching structure adds winter interest in the landscape. • This adaptable plant can be sited full sun to partial shade; drought tolerant once established. • Potting a 2 ¼" or 4" liner directly into a 2 or 3 gallon container is not recommended
