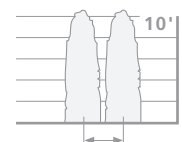

## Fastigate rose of Sharon

Purple Pillar® *Hibiscus syriacus* has a very narrow, columnar shape that makes it a tremendously useful plant in the landscape. It's more than a practical choice - it's a pretty one too, with large purple flowers in late summer. Use it for narrow hedges, screens, or as an unusual accent plant. It does not require pruning to maintain its narrow shape, but may be trimmed in late winter or early spring if needed. Winner of the Planetarium Silver Medal.
