Grower Tips:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Very fast to produce and easy to ship in bud and bloom. • Initial bloom will be on previous year's growth; rebloom occurs on new wood approximately 10-12 weeks later. • Do not allow to dry out • Trim lightly to shape as many times as possible until late July; Pruning or trimming after this will interfere with bud set for the following season. Dormant or spring pruning will also remove flower buds. • White flowers do not change color due to soil chemistry. However, the addition of aluminum results in an even cleaner, brighter white. • May be susceptible to powdery mildew and leaf spot; grow with good air circulation and practice good sanitation to reduce disease.
