- Flowers start pure white and change to red before others even start to bloom
- Very strong stems
- Reaches just 1.5-3' tall and wide ideal for landscapes, containers, flower gardens



## **Grower Tips:**

- Benefits from a dormant prune of a few inches off the top early in the spring prior to sale. If a subsequent trim must be done at the nursery before shipping, it should occur in late spring at the latest to allow flower buds to develop.
- Panicle hydrangeas prefer to fill the container with roots before they put on top growth.
- Somewhat susceptible to spider mites, scout often and treat aggressively. Avoid stress to minimize threat.
- For late season sales, avoid drought stress to preserve good flower color.
