Grower Tips:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Needs little pruning or training to develop its narrow, pyramidal form</li> <li>• Juvenile foliage is prickly and needle-like, it occurs on young plants and on shaded sections of the plant.</li> <li>• Mature foliage is soft and scale like, it occurs on old wood and actively growing sections of the plant, these branches will produce berries.</li> <li>• Potting any sized liner directly to a 3 gallon is not recommended. Rather, employ a 1 gallon shift, adding 12-14 weeks on top of the time to produce a one gallon.</li> <li>• Use a light, fast-draining growing mix.</li> </ul>
