## **Features & Benefits:**

- Non-invasive vining honeysuckle
- Very fragrant yellow two-toned flowers in early summer with sporadic rebloom through the season
- Bright red fruit follows blooming.
- Excellent for planting on pergolas, trellises, arbors, fences, and railings.

## **Grower Tips:**

- Twining vine; provide a trellis or tripod at potting time to keep plant manageable.
- Spend first season developing a robust plant body with good trimming and training on to support structure. Plant can be dormant pruned or pinched after new growth begins the following spring for a lush container presentation.
- Allow 4-6 weeks after trimming for flowers to form for sale. Blooms are triggered by long days.
- Plant will push a lot of soft growth if in very warm conditions early in the season. Keep in a cool area to minimize trimming needs and ensure best shelf-life at retail.
- Space plants appropriately in the growing range to avoid them growing into one another especially the season of sale.
- Potting a 2 ¼" liner directly into a 3 gallon can is not recommended.
