<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Non-invasive vining honeysuckle</li> <li>- Very fragrant yellow two-toned flowers in early summer with sporadic rebloom through the season</li> <li>- Bright red fruit follows blooming.</li> <li>- Excellent for planting on pergolas, trellises, arbors, fences, and railings.</li> </ul>

Grower Tips:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Twining vine; provide a trellis or tripod at potting time to keep plant manageable.</li> <li>• Spend first season developing a robust plant body with good trimming and training on to support structure. Plant can be dormant pruned or pinched after new growth begins the following spring for a lush container presentation.</li> <li>• Allow 4-6 weeks after trimming for flowers to form for sale. Blooms are triggered by long days.</li> <li>• Plant will push a lot of soft growth if in very warm conditions early in the season. Keep in a cool area to minimize trimming needs and ensure best shelf-life at retail.</li> <li>• Space plants appropriately in the growing range to avoid them growing into one another – especially the season of sale.</li> <li>• Potting a 2 ¼" liner directly into a 3 gallon can is not recommended.</li> </ul>
