Grower Tips:	
•	Hard prunes during the growing season can set the plant back, if a hard prune is needed to reset the plant, do it in the spring or fall.
•	Trim 2-3 times the first season to build a good plant body.
•	No insect issues with this plant. This plant is highly toxic if ingested.
•	Overwinter in minimum heat houses, 36°F, if growing plant in a lower hardiness zone.
