<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tidy container plant with dark foliage and good flower coverage should be an easy sell at garden centers.</li> <li>• 1-2 trims during the first growing season should create a well branched container.</li> <li>• Do not trim after July, as flowers form on old wood.</li> <li>• Dark green foliage is attractive throughout the summer.</li> <li>• Upright habit allows for minimal spacing between pots.</li> <li>• Fragrance sells, this plant is FRAGRANT.</li> </ul>
