Grower Tips:

- Easy to grow, with a very long sales window and enormous retail appeal.
- During first season, trim top portion of plant to encourage a fuller base. No need to shape plant.
- Early pruning of fine, soft growth yields best results do not cut into thick woody stems.
- A light dormant pruning the season before sale is recommended for best presentation.
- Narrow columnar form allows for closer than average spacing in the nursery.
- High night temperatures can cause leaf-drop; grow under shade in hot climates.
- Cannot be shipped to IL, MN, NH, VT, and Canada.
