Features & Benefits:

- Developed in Maine, hardier than typical rhododendrons with exceptional disease resistance.
- Large, spherical clusters of rich purple flowers with a prominent green eye in mid spring.
- High quality evergreen foliage
- A classic landscape planting for semi-shaded areas.

Grower Tips:

- Best grown in light, fast-draining media and kept on the dry side frequent watering and less-than-immediate drainage can lead to root rot and disease.
- Blooms on old wood dormant and spring pruning will remove flower buds.
- Trim up to 4 times to encourage a dense, well-branched and rounded plant, but never cut into thick stems. Doing so will result in an awkward habit and slow recovery.
- Stop trimming in late July to allow flower buds to form if selling the following season.
- A 5 gallon can be produced from a 1 gallon shift; allow 20-24 weeks to the time required to produce the 1 gallon.
- Liners are available in quick turn size only.
- An excellent plant for shipping in bloom for spring sales.
